Hilton Applefest 2023

Do you know who's C8 is pictured on the Dash Plaques and the Award Plaques for this year's Applefest awards? This was the 70th Anniversary of the Corvette so the show featured the Corvette. No clouds, 70 plus degrees, a great day to be outside in the sunshine. Past shows have had entries around 500 cars in the 33 classes. This year's Applefest had a record number of entries at over 650 cars. My last unofficial count for the 3 Corvette classes, 1953-1982 (C1-C3), 1984-2013 (C4-C6), 2014-Present (C7, C8) was around 100 cars. Previous years the total was around 80 Corvettes. Participants of the show, vote on various classes. Van Bortel was gracious enough to sponsor the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place plaques for the 2014-Present Class. Our Rochester Corvette Club stepped up by sponsoring the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place plaques for the 1953-1982 Class and the 1984-2013 Class for a total of 6 plaques. A few club members received plaques. Thom Stevens 2011 received 3rd place, Kevin Quinn's 2012 received 2nd Place and Beverly French's 2012 received 1st place. James Schaubroeck's 2021 received 3rd place, Sharon Steven's 2018 received 2nd place, Bernie Bauer's 2019 received 1st place. The RCC took home the specialty plaque for "Club Participation." The proceeds from the Applefest Car Show go to local charities around the area. The goal this year is over \$6,000. The car show is not possible without the volunteers that donate their free time to make the show possible. 


